Commercial Pilot Licence- Aeroplane

Pre-Requisites

- High School Diploma is not required but is highly recommended as a minimum
- Able to read and write in one of Canada's official languages.
- Minimum age: 18
- Transport Canada category 1 medical certificate
- Hold a private pilots licence

Requirements

- 80 hours commercial pilot ground school
- 200 hours flight time, of which at least:
 - o 35 hours must be with an instructor (dual)
 - o 100 hours must be as pilot in command (solo)
 - o 20 hour must be cross country experience
 - o 20 hours of instrument training
