- Private (PPL)
- 50 hours Pilot in Command (PIC) Cross-country
- High School Diploma required.

Requirements at completion Instrument Rating:

- 40 hours Dual Instrument Instruction
 - Up to 20 hours may be in an approved simulator
- Pass the INRAT and Instrument Rating Flight Test
